General Rules of the Young Japan Association of Arbitrators

1. Objectives of the Young Japan Association of Arbitrators (“YJAA”)

The objectives of YJAA are as follows:

- (a) To provide a platform for young practitioners involved in arbitration and other forms of alternative dispute resolution both in Japan and in other countries worldwide to exchange expertise, experience, and information in connection with arbitration and other forms of alternative dispute resolution.
- (b) To provide information about and promote the use of arbitration and other forms of alternative dispute resolution.

2. Criteria for Membership

YJAA members are required to be 40 years of age or younger and a member of Japan Association of Arbitrators (“JAA”) at the time of their application for membership.

3. The YJAA Committee

- (a) YJAA will establish a committee (the “committee”) composed of one person and committee members who are YJAA members.
- (b) The committee will manage YJAA’s operations.
- (c) The president and the other committee members will be appointed by the existing committee every two years.
